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a continuation of the gods gangsters series part three brings heroine egypt on a whole new job fulling of catching cases and bodies plunge into the heart of new york s ruthless underbelly with gods gangsters 3 where survival of the fittest isn t just a saying it s the

law rising from the city's dark corners egypt isn't your ordinary survivor she's a born predator whose early life of hardship forged her into the most deadly assassin the city has ever seen her name strikes fear and respect in equal measure across the boroughs marking her transformation from a vulnerable child to a legendary hunter in a city that bows to the bold in this explosive installment egypt takes the helm of her destiny driving full throttle into the chaos of the streets as the apex predator she navigates the perilous world of power plays and shadowy alliances where every heartbeat could be her last gods gangsters 3 is not just a story it's a high octane adventure that cements egypt's legacy as the undisputed queen of the urban jungle gear up for a narrative packed with thrilling action razor sharp betrayals and a ruthless quest for supremacy witness egypt as she claims her throne in a blood drenched odyssey that defines what it means to be the ultimate survivor gods gangsters 3 is the ultimate ride for anyone who craves heart pounding urban fiction that never lets up

gucumatz divine heart of heaven father and mother of all there is conceived the pristine forest as den for animals large and small but he never pledged it as dwelling for men because for humans the jungle is hell itself nevertheless instigated by greediness men invade its enclosure and unfailingly stumble into a collective madness that binds them to its roots preventing their escape before their time is due inhabiting the jungle men turn into beasts that despise kindness and relinquish all virtues as they submit to wickedness how can integrity be preserved living in hell for the jungle is xibalbá the dwelling of demons what do men look for in xibalbá that to live there they are willing to lose not only their lives but also their souls absolution perhaps because regardless of their origin removing the mask of greediness they wear over their feelings they reveal to be fugitives of their own consciences that arrive in xibalbá to atone remorse or expiate guilt and for that they come from different and distant localities

contemporary figurative sculptors rarely support themselves but in steps dan corbin breaking all the rules on his way to becoming a

successful studio artist corbin takes two decades to realize his art dream he makes the usual sacrifices travels the world seeks out art education finds and loses love so why is the outcome of his narrative so different corbin s enigmas are revealed in this humor leveled portrait of a man full of energy propelled by a distressed childhood seeking a higher calling and intent on full redemption raised in california corbin reinvents himself in a life filled with risk and adventure an army stint in germany began his thirst for travel living in spain santa barbara hawaii and berkeley this enables corbin to learn more about himself and others as he cobbles together an eclectic belief system based on mysticism faith and science and then attempts to develop an art style capable of expressing his new sense of self corbin s long journey is sometimes hilarious and grueling he searches inside and out and in every direction for the lost answers but ultimately finds the resolution in plain sight

ends of assimilation examines how chicano literature imagines the conditions and costs of cultural change arguing that its thematic preoccupation with assimilation illuminates the function of literature john alba cutler shows how mid century sociologists advanced a model of assimilation that ignored the interlinking of race gender and sexuality and characterized american culture as homogeneous stable and exceptional he demonstrates how chicano literary works from the postwar period to the present understand culture as dynamic and self consciously promote literature as a medium for influencing the direction of cultural change with original analyses of works by canonical and noncanonical writers from am rico paredes sandra cisneros and jimmy santiago baca to estela portillo trambley alfredo v a and patricia santana ends of assimilation demands that we reevaluate assimilation literature and the very language we use to talk about culture

el tajín an ancient mesoamerican capital in veracruz mexico has long been admired for its stunning pyramids and ballcourts decorated with extensive sculptural programs yet the city s singularity as the only center in the region with such a wealth of

sculpture and fine architecture has hindered attempts to place it more firmly in the context of mesoamerican history in lightning gods and feathered serpents rex koontz undertakes the first extensive treatment of el tajín s iconography in over thirty years allowing us to view its imagery in the broader mesoamerican context of rising capitals and new elites during a period of fundamental historical transformations koontz focuses on three major architectural features the pyramid of the niches central plaza ensemble the south ballcourt and the mound of the building columns complex and investigates the meanings of their sculpture and how these meanings would have been experienced by specific audiences koontz finds that the iconography of el tajín reveals much about how motifs and elite rites growing out of the classic period were transmitted to later mesoamerican peoples as the cultures centered on teotihuacan and the maya became the myriad city states of the early postclassic period by reexamining the iconography of sculptures long in the record as well as introducing important new monuments and contexts lightning gods and feathered serpents clearly demonstrates el tajín s numerous iconographic connections with other areas of mesoamerica while also exploring its roots in an indigenous gulf lowlands culture whose outlines are only now emerging at the same time it begins to uncover a largely ignored regional artistic culture of which tajín is the crowning achievement

the birth of the west stems from the rejection of tradition all our evidence for this influence comes from the axial period 800 400 bce baruch halpern explores the impact of changing cosmologies and social relations on cultural change in that era especially from mesopotamia to israel and greece but extending across the mediterranean not least to egypt and italy in this volume he shows how an explosion of international commerce and exchange which can be understood as a renaissance led to the redefinition of selfhood in various cultures and to reformation the process inevitably precipitated an enlightenment this has happened over and over in human history and in academic or cultural fields it is the basis of modernization or westernization wherever it occurs and whatever form it takes

in place of gods and kings presents a new reading of an important manuscript that has long been considered the foremost colonial era source for information related to the indigenous inhabitants of the mexican state of michoacán drawing on recent trends in literary studies that call into question the universal validity of notions such as the unitary author and the primacy of alphabetic writing over oral and pictorial traditions cynthia l stone shows how this early relación c 1538 41 weaves together narrative strands representing the distinctive voices of four primary contributors according to the franciscan compiler jerónimo de alcalá the manuscript is a testament to enlightened colonial officials who recognized that some familiarity with native customs and beliefs would further the goals of evangelization and spanish rule this symbolic bridge between prehispanic and colonial times was articulated differently by the friar s indigenous collaborators however who refused to accept their alleged cultural inferiority or fully renounce their previous allegiances thus the drawings of the indigenous painters reproduced in this volume in both color and black and white evoke the sacred mesoamerican tradition of writing in pictures the epic history narrated by the former high priest pays tribute to the great regional culture hero taríacuri and the account of the spanish conquest provided by the indigenous governor converts the military defeat of his people into a moral victory and a paradigm for cultural survival
